



SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION 2020-21

The Santa Ana Public Schools Foundation is pleased to provide graduating seniors from all Santa Ana Unified School District high schools with the opportunity to apply for scholarships to support their post-secondary educational goals. We encourage all eligible seniors to consider applying for these scholarships. If selected, students will be notified in March 2021, and will receive their scholarships in April 2021.

Retired Administrators \$500

5 scholarships awarded

This scholarship is for students who have achieved academic success, have been involved in community service, and have demonstrated exemplary leadership.

To qualify, students must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher.

Merit \$1,000

5 scholarships awarded

This scholarship is designed to recognize students demonstrating outstanding leadership and high academic achievement.

To qualify, students must have a GPA of 3.75 or higher.

Quick Start \$500

5 scholarships awarded

This scholarship is awarded to students who have been focused on CTE certificate programs and wish or work.

To qualify, students must have a GPA of 2.0 or better and have been enrolled in a CTE program for two consecutive school years.

Rob Richardson Civic and Community \$1,000

1 scholarship awarded

This scholarship is for students who have been highly involved in civic and community service.

To qualify, students must have a 3.0 GPA or higher.

Santa Ana Business \$1,000

1 scholarship awarded

This scholarship is awarded to one student who has worked or who has served in an internship while attending high school.

To qualify, students must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Nancy Diaz-Miller \$1,500

2 scholarships awarded

These scholarships are for students who may have had to overcome life challenges and have been actively involved in their school and/or in the local Santa Ana community.

To qualify, students must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher.

Achieve \$500

5 scholarships awarded

These scholarships are for students who have demonstrated achievement while working with an Individual Education Plan.

To qualify, students must have a GPA of 2.0 or higher.

Scholarship Application Directions

Accessing the scholarship application from school:

- Students cannot use their chromebooks to complete the scholarship application.
- Students (or adults who want to look at the student application) need to use a pc, mac or phone.
- If anyone is going to use a district computer to complete the scholarship application, they need to sign out of their saUSDlearns account (if they are logged in).
- If students have problems accessing the scholarship application from school, it is either because they didn't sign out of saUSDlearns, or their school technician might have placed further restrictions on the school computers. In which case, they need to ask the technical staff at the school for help.

Accessing the scholarship application away from school:

- If using a phone, pc or mac computer, there should be no access issues away from school. Students will not be able to use their chromebooks to complete the scholarship application from home.
