

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION 2023-2024

Application Window- October 30, 2023 - February 11, 2024

Achieve \$1000 5 scholarships

These scholarships are awarded to students who have demonstrated achievement while working with an Individual Education Plan (Special Education). To qualify, students must have a minimum GPA of 2.0.

Merit \$1,000 5 scholarships

This scholarship will be awarded to five students demonstrating outstanding leadership and high academic achievement. To qualify, students must have a minimum GPA of 4.0.

Nancy O'Connor Memorial \$2,000 2 scholarships (1 -Teen Parent)

These scholarships will be awarded to two students who have overcome the challenges of high school, while maintaining academic achievement in and plan to pursue post-secondary education in college. One must be awarded to a teen parent who has overcome challenges. Students must have a minimum GPA of 2.0. Verification of parenthood is required.

Quick Start CTE \$1000 5 scholarships

This scholarship will be awarded to five students who have been enrolled in the District's CTE certificate program for 4 semesters and express a desire to pursue a career in the field of work. To qualify student must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.

Alice Garcia Memorial \$1,000 1 scholarship

This scholarship will be awarded to one student who attended Lincoln Elementary School. The student must have an interest in entering a career in community service. (law-enforcement, fire, education, medical). To qualify, the student must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.

Retired Administrators \$1000 2 scholarships

This scholarship will be awarded to one student who wishes to pursue the field of education, has been involved in community service and school leadership. To qualify, the student must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.

Rob Richardson Civic and Community Memorial \$1,000

1 scholarship awarded

This scholarship will be awarded to one student who has been highly involved in ASB, participates in civic and community service. To qualify, students must have a minimum GPA of 3.0.

Santa Ana Business \$1000 1 scholarship

This scholarship will be awarded to one student who has worked or has served in an internship in the field of business while attending high school and expresses a desire to pursue a career in business. To qualify, the student must have a GPA of 3.0.

Visual and Performing Arts \$1,000 5 scholarships

This scholarship will be awarded to five students who have been actively involved in the school and District VAPA program for 2 or more school years. Students must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.

Floyd and Phyllis Watson NJROTC \$1,000 2 scholarships

This scholarship will be awarded to one male and one female student who has participated in NJROTC for one or more school years. Students must be enrolled in NJROTC during the senior year. Students must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.

High School Specific Scholarships

Students applying for these specific scholarships must attend the specified high school.

Santa Ana High School Students Only

Gerry Oxx Scholarship \$1,000 1 scholarship

This scholarship will be awarded to a first-generation student who has demonstrated high academic excellence and wishes to pursue higher education at a private or out of state college. Counselor Recommendation Required.

Cesar Chavez High School Students Only

Charlie Phillips Alternative Ed. Success \$1,500 1 scholarship

This scholarship will be awarded to one student who has overcome challenges and has achieved success at Cesar Chavez High School. The student must have earned a GPA of 2.0 or higher and has the goal to attend college after graduation.
