Class of 2027 Scholarship Information

Application Window – Monday November 9, 2026 – February 12, 2027

The Santa Ana Public Schools Foundation is pleased to provide graduating seniors from all Santa Ana Unified School District high schools with the opportunity to be awarded scholarships to support post-secondary educational goals. We encourage all graduating seniors to consider applying for one or more of these scholarships made available to you by funds donated by the community to the foundation for your support.

Scholarship applications are available on this website beginning **Monday, November 9, 2026**. The application window will close on **Friday, February 12, 2027**.

All applications are evaluated, and recipients are chosen by a committee consisting of volunteer Board and community members. Students selected for the scholarship will be notified by March 19, 2027, and the scholarship award will be presented at the recognition ceremony in early May 2027, (Date to be updated when confirmed.)

How to apply:

1. Please use a PC or Cell phone. A Chrome Book will not connect appropriately to the application.
2. Go to the Santa Ana Public Schools website at www.santaanapublicschoolsfoundation.org/scholarships
3. Please review the details regarding scholarships available to the class of 2027. Students may apply for multiple scholarships, but each student will be granted no more than one scholarship.
4. Select the “Apply Now” button on the bottom of the SAPSF scholarship page. Enter your details online. Attach your responses to the essay questions as a separate document using the “Choose File” button. Once you have completed the application, submit it by clicking the “Send” button.
5. The completed application must be submitted prior to the deadline on **Friday, February 12, 2027, before 11:59 pm**. Late or incomplete applications are not eligible for awards.



SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION CLASS OF 2027

The scholarships listed below are open to all Santa Ana Unified School District graduating seniors. Please read each description carefully to ensure that you meet the listed requirements.

Achieve \$1000

5 scholarships

This scholarship will be awarded to students who have demonstrated achievement while working with an Individual Education Plan (Special Education). To qualify, students must have a minimum GPA of 2.0.

Merit \$1,000

5 scholarships

This scholarship will be awarded to students demonstrating outstanding leadership and high academic achievement. To qualify, students must have a minimum GPA of 4.0.

CIF Athletics \$1,000

5 scholarships

This scholarship will be awarded to students who have participated in CIF athletics at the varsity level and are striving to continue playing that sport at the collegiate level. To qualify, students must have a minimum GPA of 2.0.

Quick Start CTE \$1000

5 scholarships

This scholarship will be awarded to students who have been enrolled in the District's CTE certificate program for 4 semesters and express a desire to pursue a career in the field. Students must have a minimum GPA of 2.0.

Alice Garcia Memorial \$1,000

1 scholarship

This scholarship will be awarded to one student who attended Lincoln Elementary School. The student must have an interest in entering a career in community service, such as law enforcement, fire service, education, or medicine. To qualify, the student must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 or higher.

SAUSD Administrators \$1000

5 scholarships

This scholarship will be awarded to students who wish to pursue a career in education and has been involved in community service and school leadership. To qualify, the student must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.

Rob Richardson Civic and Community Memorial \$1,000

1 scholarship

This scholarship will be awarded to one student who has been highly involved in ASB and participates in civic and community service. To qualify, students must have a minimum GPA of 3.0.

Visual and Performing Arts \$1,000

5 scholarships

This scholarship will be awarded to students who have been actively involved in the school and District VAPA program for 2 or more school years. Students must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.

Floyd and Phyllis Watson NJROTC \$1,000

2 scholarships

This scholarship will be awarded to one male and one female student who have participated in NJROTC for one or more school years. Students must be enrolled in NJROTC during their senior year. Students must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.

Paul Brazer Memorial \$1,000

1 scholarship

This scholarship will be awarded to one student interested in entering the fields of construction or engineering and be active in school activities. The student must maintain a GPA of 2.0 or higher.

SAEA Scholarships \$1000

5 scholarships

This scholarship will be awarded to a student who will enter the field of education. The student must be actively involved in school and community events. The student must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.

CSEA Scholarships \$1,000

3 scholarships

This scholarship will be awarded to students who are the child, grandchild, or sibling of a classified employee of the Santa Ana Unified School District. The student must be actively involved in school and community events. The student must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 and have the goal of attending college or university.

Pechanga Native American Scholarship \$1,000

Up to 5 scholarships

This scholarship will be awarded to students who are actively involved in the Native American community. Students must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 and wish to continue their education at the community college or university level. Students must identify the Native American tribe with which they are affiliated.

Power Suites Network \$1,000

5 Scholarships

This scholarship will be awarded to students who are interested in pursuing careers in business or a business-related field, demonstrate involvement in school and community activities, and have maintained a GPA of 3.25 or higher.

Santa Ana High School Students Only

Gerry Oxx Scholarship \$1,000

1 scholarship

This scholarship will be awarded to one senior who has demonstrated leadership skills, is a first-generation college-going student, and will apply to private colleges and universities across the country.

Cesar Chavez High School Students Only

Charlie Phillips Alternative Ed. Success \$1,500

1 scholarship

This scholarship will be awarded to one student who has overcome challenges and has achieved success at Cesar Chavez High School. The student must have earned a GPA of 2.0 or higher
